## **Background**

The Blueprint for Good Growth is a collaborative multi-jurisdictional effort to coordinate land use and public facility decisions. The plan establishes an overall framework for growth management in Ada County that includes policies and strategies that ultimately will be incorporated into the plans, regulations and practices of Ada County, its cities, Ada County Highway District (ACHD) and the Idaho Transportation Department (ITD).

The project was initiated in summer of 2004. A Consortium of elected officials adopted Phase I Goals, Objectives, and Policies in September 2006 (available for download at [www.blueprintforgoodgrowth.com](http://www.blueprintforgoodgrowth.com)). The Phase II Implementation Stage is expected to continue through winter 2007/2008. Blueprint for Good Growth, Inc. is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization.

## **Consortium**

The Ada County Consortium is a partnership of governments responsible for local land use and roadway planning within Ada County. The Consortium's members include elected officials from Ada County; the Cities of Boise, Eagle, Garden City, Meridian, Kuna, and Star; the Ada County Highway District; and the Idaho Transportation Department. These partners strive to better coordinate land use and transportation planning to ensure that growth is orderly and beneficial for continued prosperity and quality of life for the residents of Ada County.

## **Steering and Technical Committees**

The Steering Committee membership is comprised of diverse stakeholders including representatives from Ada County; the Cities of Boise, Eagle, Garden City, Meridian, Kuna, and Star; the Ada County Highway District; and the Idaho Transportation Department, Boise Metro and Eagle Chambers of Commerce, Affordable Housing, Agriculture, Boise River Flood Control District No. 10, COMPASS, Contracting Community, Residential and Commercial Development, Economic Development, Idaho Smart Growth, Large Employers, Neighborhoods, Public Schools, University of Idaho, Urban Land Institute, Urban Redevelopment, and Valley Regional Transit.

## **Communities in Motion**

The Blueprint plan was developed in coordination with the Communities in Motion Regional Long-Range Transportation Plan 2030, adopted on August 21, 2006 by the Board of the Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho (COMPASS). Communities in Motion established and evaluated numerous growth scenarios that are described in the appendix of the Blueprint for Good Growth Plan. The policies established in the Blueprint for Good Growth are consistent with and complementary to those included in the Long Range Transportation Plan.
